Chapter 2. About the product

Unica Link provides both design-time and runtime services. It is invoked at design-time when an administrator configures a Link connection, or when you configure a process box in the Unica Campaign application, or a touchpoint in the Unica Journey application.

Unica Link is a component that can be installed separately from the Unica application. It must be installed in a Linux environment that can be remote from the Unica platform.

Unica Link supports the following connectors:

- Mailchimp connector The Mailchimp connector uploads contact information to an
 audience in Mailchimp, populating the merge field defined for the Audience. It then
 creates a segment of the audience for the uploaded contacts, and optionally runs or
 schedules a Mailchimp campaign to target the segment. The connector then polls
 Mailchimp on a scheduled basis to gather the results of the campaign, and to report
 back whether emails were delivered, bounced, opened or links clicked within the
 emails.
- Mandrill connector The Mandrill connector sends email using a defined template on a Mandril account, populating the merge field defined in that template. The connector then polls Mandrill to report whether emails were bounced, opened, or links clicked within the email.
- Salesforce connector Salesforce (CRM) saves and updates details about users. Salesforce supports two operations, 'Create' and 'Update', as well as two objects 'Lead' and 'Contact'. Also supported are two objects, 'Lead' and 'Contact'.
- Twilio connector The Twilio connector sends SMS to a destination device and fetches the status of the sent SMS.
- Facebook AdTech (Added in release 12.1.0.3) The Facebook connector uploads contact information into an existing, or new audience in Facebook.
- LinkedIn AdTech (Added in release 12.1.0.3) The LinkedIn connector uploads contact information into an existing, or new audience in LinkedIn.

Chapter 3. Known issues

The following table lists the known issues in Unica Link 12.1.0.3

Product	Description
Link	Removing a Unica application does not remove the artifacts created for the application.
	Workaround:
	Inside the <install_dir> or the Unica installation directory, run the script remove_application.sh.</install_dir>
	To execute the remove_application.sh script, run the following command: remove_application.sh vul> <username> <password> <application></application></password></username>
	where:
	 <base-url> is the base URL for Link server. This should be of form: https://<host-name>:8443. If defaults were used during installation, then the default port is 8443.</host-name></base-url> <username> and <password> are the credentials for an administrative user for Unica Link.</password></username> <application> is the name of the application.</application>
	When the command execution is successful, it provides details about the deleted project and packages. An example is as follows:

Facebook AdTech connector	Unicode characters do not work on Windows
Facebook AdTech connector	The Connection is failed. The returned status is 400 with response { "error": { "message": " (#2635) then you are using an out of date Ads API version. Please update to the latest version v12.0.
	Workaround:
	Update Base URL connection property on UI to include the correct version as stated in the error message.
	Base URL: URL plus version: https:// <fb< td=""></fb<>
	For example - https://graph.facebook.com/v11.0
	So, if your base URL is https://graph.facebook-
	.com/v11.0 and you click on test connection then it
	shows the above error message and it says to use
	v12.0, then update it in base-URL for the following.

LinkedIn AdTech connector	An error is returned if you remove an Ad Account and then attempt to create a new Segment Action for an existing configured Link PB.
LinkedIn AdTech connector	You can edit Upload Type in the LinkedIn connector if you re-open the Link in the Link Process Box (PB).
LinkedIn AdTech connector	Unicode characters do not work on Windows.
Mailchimp connector	In Mailchimp, the audience value changes to another format.
	The audience value shows its ID (in alphanumeric format) instead of its value when you edit the correctly configured Action (Link PB).
Mailchimp connector	Email Delivered and Email Sent events are not received for Mailchimp.
Mailchimp connector	You must be aware of merge fields and type them correctly in the subject field in order to correctly merge personalized information into email. If you want to use merge fields in Subject you must type the fields correctly in order to merge personal-
	ized information into email. An example of correct formatting is: * FirstName *. Similarly, to merge a product and a city into an email subject line, you would use a format such as this: Welcome to * Product * Seminar in * City *.
Mailchimp connector	The fetch results will not fetch results for the last day. For example, if you select the current day, then no result will be populated. The same as if you select a

	fetch end date as 25th June, it will fetch results till 24th June. The results for last day are missed.
Mailchimp connector	Unicode characters do not work on Windows.
Mandrill connector	In Mandrill, non-Latin alphabetic characters are not supported in Merge fields.
Mandrill connector	You must be aware of merge fields and type them correctly in the subject field in order to correctly merge personalized information into email.
	If you want to use merge fields in Subject you must type the fields correctly in order to merge personal- ized information into email.
	An example of correct formatting is: * FirstName *. Similarly, to merge a product and a city into an email subject line, you would use a format such as this: Welcome to * Product * Seminar in * City *.
Mandrill connector	This issue involves, Email Delivered and Email Sent events which are not received for Mandrill.
Mandrill connector	If the Mandrill touchpoints are used with Salesforce touchpoints in the Journey application, the publish option will fail.
Mandrill connector	The Switch to Text field option in the Field Mapping screen does not work.
Mandrill connector	Unicode characters do not work on Windows.
Salesforce connector	If the Salesforce touchpoints are used with Mandrill touchpoints in the Journey application, the publish option will fail.
Salesforce connector	Unicode characters do not work on Windows.

Product	Description
Twilio connector	The Switch to Text field option in the Field Mapping screen does not work.
Twilio connector	Unicode characters do not work on Windows.

Chapter 4. Known limitations

The following table lists the known limitations in Unica Link 12.1.0.3

Product	Description
Mailchimp connector	Mailchimp results are available for 1000 users only, per batch.
	This is due to a limitation in the Mailchimp API.
Mandrill connector	The User Mail Open/Click responses are available on the Mandrill site only, post a delay ranging from 10 to 15 hours. This is a limitation of the Mandrill service.
