Audit logging with info from Siteminder

A new parameter "Additional header variable" is added under Platform configuration node HCL Unica | Unica Platform | Security | Login method details | Web Access Control.

This parameter can contain a comma separated list of http header variables that will be stored in audit tables each time a user logs in through web access control.

The value for these http header variables can be seen in the audit event report, by more in the event detail column.
